In 2005, WIPCE was held in Hamilton, Aotearoa – New Zealand from 27 November to 1 December. Elders Murdena and Albert Marshall from the Mi'kmaw Nation joined with other people from around the world ... attendance was in the thousands. The research program of CRC in Integrative Science Dr. Cheryl Bartlett enabled their participation, financially and logistically.
